Past activities: collaboration with partners



- Sending out a **questionnaire** on 23 September and 23 October asking for information about the progress of the scientific content of their projects
- Results:
 - 1st response: 30% partners of which only a 40% had completed the questionnaire
 - Only in January 2010 were all the questionnaires sent
 - Partners were quite reluctant to fill in and send the questionnaire
- Comments:
 - Answering –at least something- the requests of the Project Management Team is mandatory. Not doing so, besides impolite, disrupts the course of the project

- There has been cooperation between the partners and the scientists
- The contact has been more intensive in the activities to be held in 2009 and early 2010

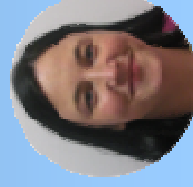

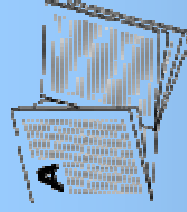
